### **Casting Basics**

This clinic will deal with the basic mechanics of casting, what makes a good cast good and how to diagnose problems and fix them. It is designed to suit from beginners to those who have been fishing for ages but are self taught and struggle to get the line to do what they want it to.

**There will be two clinics on the day each running for approximately 3 hours  
First commencing at 9.00AM to 12.00PM  
Second running from 1.00PM to 4.00PM
